Meadowlark Hills Patrons,

The first week of resuming play for Elite Pass, Season Pass, and Existing Punch Card Holders has gone well. Thank you, golfers for being responsible on the course and following all of the precautions. As we continue to evaluate safety on the golf course, we are making the following adjustments effective Monday, May 4, 2020:

- Hours of operation will expand to 8AM-8PM, Monday-Sunday
 - All carts must be returned by 8PM
- Tee times will now be spaced in 15-minute intervals, instead of 18 minutes.
- In addition to Elite Passes & Season Passes, Punch Cards can now be purchased. Passes and cards can only be purchased over the phone using a credit card. Thus, only players with Elite Passes, Season Passes or Punch Cards may utilize the course. Paying a daily green fee is currently not an option.
- Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes prior to your tee time.

In an effort to continue to provide for the safety of staff, and offer a controlled environment for players, the following will continue:

- Tee times can only be booked over the phone six days in advance. Call between 8AM-8PM. Provide the names of all players when booking.
- Please give us a courtesy call, at 233-3265, when your group arrives for your tee time.
- Punch Card holders may only include people from their household. No other guests may be invited. Staff will record redeemed punches and then punch the cards at a later date.
- Carts will continue to be offered to all golfers. Carts will remain single riders only, unless golfers live in the same household. Carts will be sanitized by staff after use.
- The driving range, putting green, concessions, patio, and pro shop will remain closed.
- Maintain 6' social/physical distance at all times on the course, in the parking lot, etc.
- Inverted PVC inserts will be used on each hole to avoid the necessity of removing or touching the flag stick.
- Players are advised to not share golf equipment, unless from the same household.
- The restroom near hole #2 will be open to players.
- Please fill your water bottles at home. The water coolers on the course will not be available.
- Playing privileges can be suspended for those not abiding by these instructions.
