COVID-19 Re-Opening with restrictions Phase-Two begins on June 8

Golf Course

- Hours of Operation: 8:00AM to Sundown (Sunday-Saturday)
- We prefer that patrons don't show up too early for their tee time (15-30 minutes prior to tee time)
- The golf course will open to public play (daily fees) with restrictions.
- Tee times may be booked up to six days in advance.
- All players can now enter the building to check-in. All Punch cards will be punched.
- Tee times will be set to 10-minute intervals.
- Driving range and practice green will open back up.
 - Max of 15 patrons allowed on the range at a time and must use the hitting stations provided.
 - Max of 15 on the practice green at a time.
- On the range please use the stalls when hitting balls. If there isn't a stall available please wait until one frees up.
- Only debit or credit card payments will be taken.
- Allowing two players to a cart. However, maintain same the same driver.
- We will still utilize the raised cup on the greens (including practice green).
- All drinking water stations remain closed.
- Ball washers and bunker rakes are not on the course. Please smooth the sand with your shoes.
- Patrons will enter through the East door for pro shop access and checking in only.
- Shopping will be allowed in the proshop. Avoid touching merchandise unless purchasing.
- Please limit your time in the proshop to allow others to come in.
- Clubhouse lounge & restrooms will remain closed (unless emergency) until further notice.
 - Restroom usage on hole 2&4 and hole 14 only.

Concessions

- Concessions will be sold through the west window.
- Condiments will be prepacked and available upon request.
- All alcoholic beverages must be purchased from MHGC (using window).

Leagues & Lessons

- Not allowing tournaments or leagues until further notice.
- Lessons may be conducted however masks must be worn and no more than 6 students allowed per lesson.

Staff

- All indoor staff must wear gloves and a mask is optional.
- All staff shall remain in their workspace and practice social distancing.
- Staff will continue sanitizing carts and outdoor restrooms.
- Proshop counter and snack bar window will have a plexiglass screen at the front counter.
- Staff will place revised instructions and a guidelines on carts.
