

# MEADOWLARK HILLS GOLF COURSE COVID-19 GUIDELINES

## **BEGINNING NOVEMBER 23, 2020**

With the COVID-19 Pandemic ongoing the health and safety of our staff and patrons is our top priority. Below is a list of guidelines to read and follow until further notice. These guidelines are subject to change.

If you are in self-quarantine then please stay home and do not enter our building or play golf.

### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- Ⓜ Masks are required inside.
- Ⓜ Do not play if you feel sick or are experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms.
- Ⓜ Maximum Occupancy 20 people.
- Ⓜ Elite Pass Members may call the pro-shop to check in for play.
- Ⓜ November Hours of Operation: 10:00AM to Sundown (Sunday-Saturday Weather Permitting)
  - Ⓢ Course closed if temperatures are below 40 degrees.
  - Ⓢ Golf Course will be closed for the Thanksgiving Holiday Weekend.

### **GOLF COURSE**

- Ⓜ Tee times may be booked up to six days in advance.
- Ⓜ Tee times will remain at 10-minute intervals.
- Ⓜ Please don't pull or rotate the flags as maintenance will change flag/hole locations daily.
- Ⓜ Do not play if you have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or have been out of the country within the last 14 days.

### **GOLF CARTS**

- Ⓜ Due to COVID-19 and the severity of the pandemic we will now allow single rider carts to be rented by individuals that do not live in the same household until further notice.
  - Ⓢ Cart rates are \$11 for nine holes and \$14 for eighteen holes.

### **CLUBHOUSE AND SNACK BAR**

- Ⓜ Entrance – Patrons can enter through the East door only.
- Ⓜ Pro-Shop & Snack bar –The Snack Bar lounge will be open for beverages and snacks.

### **GATHERINGS AND RENTALS**

- Ⓜ As per Directed Health Measures, all indoor gatherings will be limited to 25% of our rated occupancy, therefore only 20 persons will be allowed for gatherings in the clubhouse. Patrons are asked to wear a mask and maintain a six-feet of social distance between groups of eight or less while in the clubhouse, outside patio, and parking lot.
